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CONCEPTUAL FRAMING OF STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Manja Klemenčič



Dr Manja Klemenčič is senior researcher in studies of higher education at Faculty of Education, University of Ljubljana and continues to be associated at Faculty of Arts and Sciences at Harvard University where she taught higher education for the past ten years.

Klemenčič has over 150 publications and over 80 keynotes and invited lectures on a broad array of higher education topics, including student representation and participation in higher education, institutional research and quality assurance, internationalization, and different aspects of higher education reforms.

She is Editor of the Bloomsbury Handbook of Student Politics and Representation in Higher Education (2024), Co-Editor of the Routledge International Handbook on Student-Centered Learning and Teaching in Higher Education (2020), and Co-Editor of the International Encyclopaedia of Higher Education Systems and Institutions published by Springer Nature (2020).

Since 2014, Klemenčič serves as Editor-in-Chief of European Journal of Higher Education (Routledge Education, Taylor & Francis) since 2015, as Co-editor of book series Understanding Student Experiences in Higher Education (Bloomsbury) and from July 2022, as Co-editor of book series Higher Education Dynamics (Springer).

She regularly serves as a consultant for the European Commission and other international organizations, governments, quality assurance agencies and universities.
